To support this term's topic, Year 4 are visiting Wroxeter Roman City on Monday 5th March (weather depending). The aim of the trip is for children to develop an understanding of how the Romans impacted on Great Britain. We will be travelling by school mini bus, leaving school at 9.15 and arriving back at school for 3.30. It is a fantastic archaeological site managed by English Heritage. The children will be using audio tours around the main part of the site, visiting the museum to look at artefacts and drawing a replica of a town house.

The cost of the trip is £6.00 this must be paid via your ParentPay Account. This includes a Roman coin to bring home and a hot chocolate. **Home clothes can be worn with sensible footwear (trainers or walking boots).** Please wrap up warm as most of the day will be outdoors.
