Year 6 will be visiting the Imperial War Museum on Tuesday 27th March 2018.

Over the past couple weeks, Year 6 pupils have been studying L.S. Lowry and creating Lowry inspired artwork. On this trip, the children will have an opportunity to engage with Lowry's work first-hand, as well as delve deeper into the realities of World War 2, discussing the lessons that can be learned.
