Re : Year 2 Visit to Martineau Gardens, Edgbaston – Friday 27th April 2018

During our Science week, Year 2 will be learning all about plants. They will be observing and describing how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants, and developing their understanding of what plants need to grow and stay healthy. As part of this learning, they will be going on a school trip to Martineau Gardens in Edgbaston. The children will have a tour of the gardens and attend a workshop called “Professor Plant”.

The cost of the trip is £6 per child, which must be paid by Tuesday 24th April via your ParentPay Account. The children do not require spending money.

The children will be travelling by school mini-bus, both to and from the Gardens, leaving school at 9.30am and returning by the end of the school day.
