Re : Year 3 Visit to Sarehole Mill on Friday 16th November 2018

Year 3 will be visiting Sarehole Mill on Friday 16th November, to cement their knowledge of the Stone Age. The children will be exploring life in the Stone and Bronze Age, investigating tools and materials in each period. They will be handling genuine prehistoric artifacts, building shelters, and exploring a real Bronze Age historic site in local woodland.

The cost will be £11 per child (which includes a “goodie bag”), which must be paid via your ParentPay Account by Monday 12th November 2018.

The children will be travelling by school mini-bus, leaving school at approximately 9.30am and returning to school by the end of the school day.

Children will need to wear full school uniform.

The school will provide a packed lunch.
