

Uniform

All items of uniform must be clearly named.

Daywear (boys):

- White shirt (long or short sleeve)
- School tie – a choice of clip-on or tie-up
- Navy blue V-neck jumper with logo
- Navy blue blazer with logo
- Charcoal grey trousers with logo
- Grey socks

Daywear (girls):

- White button-to-neck blouse (long or short sleeve)
- School tie – a choice of clip-on or tie-up
- Navy blue cardigan with logo OR V-neck jumper with logo
- Navy blue blazer with logo
- Taylor Tartan skirt OR graphite trousers with logo
- Navy blue tights or white ankle socks

Summer term (after Easter until October half term): Girls to wear reverse collar short-sleeve white blouse with logo (no tie)

PE Kit

- The correct kit should be worn for all PE lessons and fixtures.
- It is not to be worn around school. The only exception is when team members have been instructed by a member of staff to change early.

PE Kit (boys):

- Navy and white AKOA unisex polo shirt OR games jersey with logo
- Navy and white AKOA shorts with logo
- Navy and white AKOA track pants with logo
- A choice of either navy and white AKOA hoody OR mid-layer with logo
- Navy and white SGSE football socks

PE Kit (girls):

- Navy and white AKOA female fit polo shirt OR unisex polo shirt with logo
- Navy and white AKOA skirt with logo
- A choice of either navy and white AKOA track pants with logo OR navy AKOA leggings with logo
- A choice of either navy and white AKOA hoody OR mid-layer with logo
- Navy and white SGSE football socks

Uniform and Appearance

- Students are required to be neat and tidy at all times.
- Students should follow the new uniform item expectations.
- Shirts and blouses are to be fastened to the neck and tucked into the waistband of trousers and skirts.
- Blazers must be worn around school.
- Coats should be normal outdoor coats with no large markings. Coats should be blue or black only. These should not be worn in the school building.
- Shoes must be plain black with no markings or brandings on.
- Students are not allowed any jewellery. Students may wear a pair of small studs to be removed for PE.
- No hats, scarves or gloves are to be worn within the school building or grounds.
- No hoodies should be worn in school.
- Formal black belts to be worn with trousers.
- Shoulder length hair (or longer) must be tied up for health and safety reasons.
- Haircuts should not include tramlines or patterns being shaved into hair.
- Cosmetics should be kept to a minimum. Nail varnish and nail extensions are not permitted in school
